

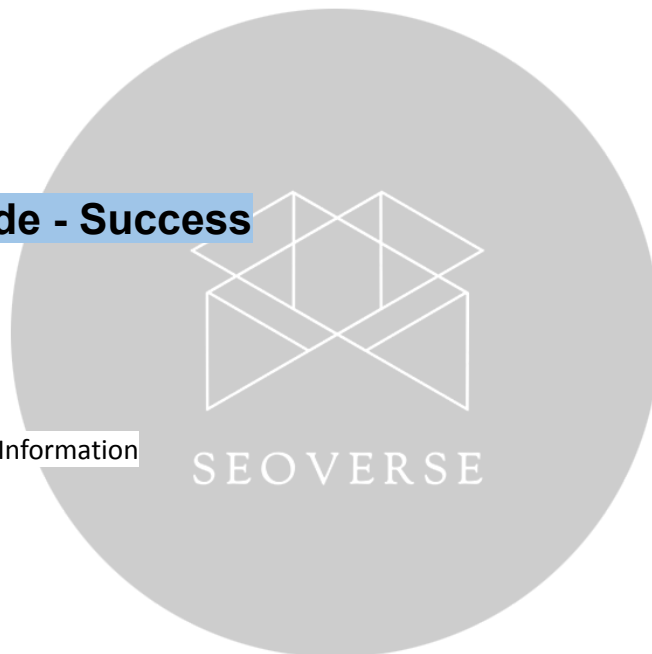
HTTP STATUS CODE CHEAT SHEET

1xx Status Codes - Informational responses

- 100 : Continue
- 101 : Switching Protocol
- 102 : Processing

2xx Status Code - Success

- 200 : OK
- 201 : Created
- 202 : Accepted
- 203 : Non-Authoritative Information
- 204 : No Content
- 205 : Reset Content
- 206 : Partial Content
- 207 : Multi-Status



3xx Status Code - Redirection

- 300 : Multiple Choices
- 301 : Moved Permanently

301 - Moved Permanently: The asset that was mentioned has been moved to another permanent and new URI, and the server is processing and redirecting your request to the new URI.

- 302 : Temporary

302 - Temporary: The asset that was mentioned has been moved to another temporary and new URI, and the server is processing and redirecting your request to the new URI.

303 : See Other

304 : Not Modified

305: Use Proxy

307 : Temporary Redirect

307 - Temporary Redirect: A 307 is more specific unlike a 302 redirect. The server doesn't see the request and the browser implements the redirect on its own. It is often used on websites that are served on HTTPS when they are on the [HSTS](#) preload list.

401 : Unauthorised

402 : Payment Required

403 : Forbidden

404 : Not Found

413 : Request Entity Too Large

414 : Request URL Too Long

5xx Status Code - Server Error

500 : Internal Server Error

501 : Not Implemented

502 : Bad Gateway

503 : Service Unavailable

503 - Service Unavailable: The server could not deal with your HTTP demand at that point. This could be because of a server crash, server over-burden, server maintenance or other different reasons.

504 : Gateway Timeout

505 : HTTP Version Not Supported

506 : Variant Also Negotiates

507 : Insufficient Storage

509 : Bandwidth Limit Exceeded

510 : Not Extended

511 : Network Authentication Required

550 : Permission Denied
